### Subject of the Disclosure

Filing of Current Report Under Section 17 of the Securities Regulation Code Amid COVID-19 Pandemic.

### Background/Description of the Disclosure

This is in compliance with the requirement of the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") to disclose the effect of the COVID-19 on the business operation of Roxas and Company, Inc. ("RCI") and the measures that are being taken address the same.

RCI's holdings company office located in Makati, NCR will be subject to the Quarantine Implementing rules set by the city. Our businesses engaged in hotel operations, particularly those located within Metro Manila, may be affected given the guidelines of the quarantine set by the different LGUs. The quarantine will likewise possibly affect occupancy in the Tagaytay Resort since most of its clientele are from NCR. Our coconut processing plant in Tupi, South Cotabato and the real estate developments in Batangas, are not expected to have significant effect at the moment due to the nature of its business.

RCI and its subsidiaries have taken extra precautions to stop the spread of the virus. Flexible work arrangements, including work from home of its employees, are being undertaken. All of its properties/sites are regularly disinfected. All employees, guests and visitors at our hotels are required to undergo temperature scanning upon entry. Alcohol/disinfectants have been provided in all entry points and strategic places in the buildings. Employees have also been made aware of and trained to follow protocol for suspected COVID-19 cases.

RCI's primary focus is the health and safety of all its stakeholders.
